New School Build

I hope this letter finds you well. As the head of school, I am excited to share some wonderful news regarding the future of our school's infrastructure.

We are pleased to announce that the construction of our new school building is set to commence shortly. This project marks a significant milestone in our commitment to providing the best possible learning environment for our children.

The new building will feature state-of-the-art classrooms, enhanced sports facilities, a modern library, and numerous other amenities designed to enrich the educational experience of your children. We believe that these upgrades will significantly benefit our entire school community. Our new teaching block, sports centre extension and refurbishment of the Hall and surrounding areas is due for completion for October 2026.

Some practical considerations

Parking

The new teaching block will be situated on our current staff and visitor car park, our new staff car park will be placed on the top yard and slightly extended onto one of our fields. This means that we will have limited spaces in the short term. Parents who drive children to and from school will have to drop them on Greenfield Way. The staff parking will be fenced (for the safety of children) and locked during the day. Parents coming in for a meeting should be able to park in the current visitor space at the front of the school, however these spaces will be limited due to some accessibility spaces being needed for some staff.

Routines for children

We will be sharing some slight changes to line ups and break/lunch break out spaces with the children on Monday, and these changes will be in place from Tuesday onwards.

Children will have the exact same access to toilets and breaktime facilities as they do now.

Y11 exams

I would like to reassure parents and children sitting their exams, that all plans to manage these changes have been made with the smooth running of exams being at the forefront of all plans and decisions. I would also like to take this opportunity to thank our Y11 for their commitment, determination and resilience during the exam period so far, and to continue to wish them the very best of luck in the upcoming exams.
