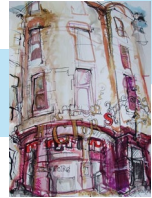
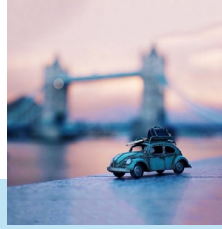
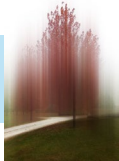
Final submission of all work once exam is completed and teachers to start the marking and moderation process.



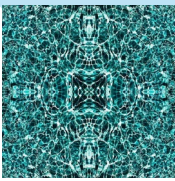
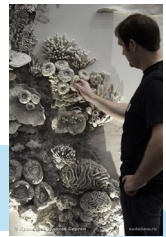
AO4- 10Hour Exam  
Creation of final outcome in exam conditions. Usually spans over a week and exams take place over March and first week in April.



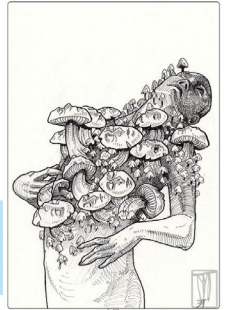
Prep deadline- End of February/ beginning of March. Teacher will set exact date. This deadline covers AO1, AO2 and Ao3.



Check point to ensure all students have a clear plan for 10 hour exam and final outcome.



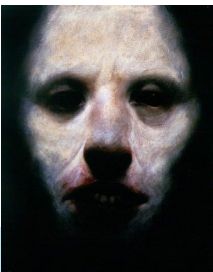
AO3  
This assessment objective runs through all aspects of the course and each assessment objective. It is about the quality of your visual and written recording including own recorded photographs.



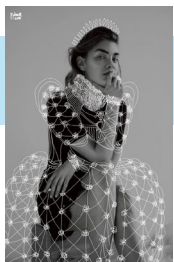
AO2  
Exploring and developing own ideas in relation to starting point and inspired by chosen artist. Exploring media and technique both visually and through supporting written analysis.



AO1  
Research into chosen artist/ question and starting point/theme. Visual responses to the style of chosen artist and techniques and media used.



January- Exam paper issued to students. Students select a question/ theme to respond to. Prep period begins



Between September and December in year 11 students will be refining coursework projects ready for final submission in December. In the January of year 11 students will begin the exam process and will select a set question from the exam paper issued by the exam board.
